

# Welcome to the Morse Code Puzzle!!!



The challenges involve listening to an audio recording of a morse code message. Once you decode and present the message to Mr. Rowe, you can redeem your prize (sweets). Parents are welcome to help!! :)

The solutions must be hand written by the student submitting them.

There are three messages

1. A straightforward message (a quote from a mathematician)
2. Another straightforward message (a quote from a famous person)
3. A Morse Code message that contains a substitution cipher. (another quote)

a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z
